Our main destination for this tour is a large village just outside Wrexham. It is known as one of the centres of the Welsh Revival of 1904-05, where a visiting Baptist preacher, R.B.Jones held a campaign in Penuel Baptist Chapel in November 1904.

According to UK Wells (Marcel, n.d.), *“One commentator said that the town was ‘ablaze and the converts number 100 already’. By March 1905 the converts in the area were numbered at 2,267. By the end of 1905, the town had changed. Prayer meetings were being held in the coal mines, family feuds were settled and drinking declined.”*

Other meetings were held at Bethlehem Welsh Independent Chapel, which is a few streets away from Penuel Baptist. We will be visiting both these chapels on our tour. (Access to the inside of the buildings may not be possible due to local restrictions and limitations.)

- ❖ St. Dyfnog’s Church, Llanrhaeadr.
